ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The George E. Peters Adventist School holds the view that the use of technology in this school is vital to the fulfillment of the goals of the curriculum and the administrative functions of the school. As a result, the school makes available to the faculty, staff, and students the opportunity to utilize its various computers for general use and to access the Internet for legitimate purposes. This opportunity is a privilege, and not a right.

The following acceptable use policy is designed for the safety and protection of the entire school family. Each user of the school's computers is required to honor and follow these guidelines.

- 1. Do not bring any food or drinks where you will be using the computer, nor consume food or drink near a computer, even if it is not turned on.
- 2. Be careful in your use of the equipment. They are sensitive and can result in lost work and time.
- 3. If you access the Internet, do not intentionally access any site with questionable contents, such as pictures, chat rooms, Facebook, Twitter, etc.
- 4. Do not use computers for any illegal activity, such as copying of others materials, threatening others, or discriminating against others.
- 5. After finishing your work, log off all programs before you leave the computer.
- 6. Do not give or lend your password to anyone.
- 7. Do not download any material that is illegal or which you intend to use without proper credit, except for legitimate teaching purposes.
- 8. Do not insert into any computer, any disk that you brought from home or anywhere outside the school, without first checking with a teacher or administrator.
- 9. Follow all rules regarding computer usage that is posted in the computer lab or near any computer.
